IT Industry by the Numbers

CompTlA's IT Industry Outlook 2017 report indicates a growing skills gap in the tech sector, forcing organizations to rethink workforce and recruitment strategies

900K new jobs in IT sector from 2009 – 2018¹

4 of 10 US IT firms report having job openings they are actively recruiting for 2

34% of employers list a lack of skills as their primary organizational challenge 3

97% of HR managers use IT certifications to distinguish between equally qualified candidates 4

80% of certified individuals claim their certification helped them get their foot in the door for a job interview 4

90% of HR managers say IT certified workers are more likely to be promoted than those without certifications 4
